



Answers to questions from the Sunday, January 31st coaches' presentation.

1. Players will line up along the lane lines as usual during the duration of the free throw sequence, unless a change is dictated by the health department to only line up during the last free throw of the sequence.
2. Time Out (TO) vs Mask Break (MB) administration.
 - A. The administration of the TO vs MB will be in the order in which they occur. If a TO is the action that stops the clock at or after the 4:00 minute mark of any quarter, the TO will be administered first followed by the MB. If a violation or common foul stops the clock, which triggers a MB, and then a coach or player requests a TO, the MB will be administered first followed by the TO.
 - B. If the TO is administered first, the MB will be administered AFTER the players return to the floor.
3. Per CIAC exemption, if a team has purchased the gaiter t-shirts, disregard the color restriction. For example, if a team purchased white gaiter t-shirts, they can wear those white gaiter t-shirts with their away uniforms. If they purchased the color of their away uniforms, they can wear them at home with the white jerseys.
